(Believe it or not, Daisy can cook)

HALF-BAKED POTATOES

Scrub any good sized potatoes, cut in half to expose the largest surface. Wash, dry. Spread cut surface with butter or margarine, or place a half strip of bacon under each half. Place in fry pan face down, cover securely. Cook on top of range for about 30 minutes. Test with fork. MAKE PLENTY OF THESE.

I have found that 30 minutes is sufficient and I prefer bacon. They are quick and easy, just put them in a pan and forget for 30 minutes. I use an electric pan and use 330 degrees.
