BETTE FREE'S SURPRISE MEAT PIE

4 Tablespoons minced onion  
1 lb. ground beef  
1 can tomato soup  
1 teaspoon salt  
1/8 teaspoon pepper  
1 tablespoon butter  
Rich pastry

Cook onions in butter till soft. Add meat and brown, drain fat. Add soup and seasonings. Line 9" pie pan with pastry rolled 1/8" thick. Fill with meat mixture. Cover with top crust and seal edges. Prick top and brush with melted butter. Bake in 450 oven for 15 min. Then decrease heat to 350 and bake 15 min. longer.
