UOSAT Rescue Involves Major Resource

Attempts are continuing to unlock the University of Surry Amateur Satellite (UOSAT) from It's current mode of operation, that being it having both the 2M and 706M transmitters on at the same time. The 150 foot parabolic dish at stanford research institute will be used in an attempt to uplink commands. The dish yeilds approximately 42Dbd of gain which is an ERP of approximately 12 MEGAWatts when fed with 750 Watts. As one AMSAT pundit put it "at these flux levels, UOSAT will respond to comand... or incandese... or BOTH!!! The only real Question is which will occur first." No news yet on whether it works yet!
